ORDINANCE #11

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DEPOSIT OF SNOW ON PUBLIC STREETS

The Village Board of the Village of Arpin, Wood County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: UNLAWFUL TO DEPOST SNOW:

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons or corporations, to pile or otherwise deposit snow from their private drives or parking areas on any public street, road or alley within the Village of Arpin. It shall be the person, persons or corporations responsibility to keep sidewalks free of snow and/or ice within the Village.

SECTION 2: PENALTY:

It the event any person, persons or corporations violate this Ordinance, the Village of Arpin may cause such deposit of snow to be removed from the street, sidewalk, road or alley and charge the cost thereof to the property owner. Such cost may be collected in the manner used to collect special assessments against real estate.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have passed the other provisions, sections, sub sections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 4: REPEALER:

All ordinances of the Village of Arpin, which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after passage and publication as provided by law.
