ORDINANCE #23

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A CURFEW

The Village Board of the Village of Arpin, Wood County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: CURFEW PROVISIONS:

- (1) No person seventeen years of age or younger shall be on, remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys or public places in the Village of Arpin between the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am unless such person is accompanied by a parent, guardian or some person of lawful age having the legal custody of such person, or unless he/she is in the performance of an errand or duty directed by such parent, guardian or other person, or unless he is going home from school activities, or unless his employment makes it necessary for him to be upon said streets, alleys or public places, in which case this Ordinance shall not apply.
- (2) Any such minor shall have reasonable time after school activities, church programs, approved organizational activities, not to exceed one hour after termination of such meeting to be within the definition of the term "going home".
- (3) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be warned by any police officer to go home and if such person shall disobey such warning, he or she may be taken to his or her home by the police officer.
- (4) Any parent or guardian who permits his child or children to violate the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance, after having been warned once in writing, shall be punished by a forfeiture of Thirty Dollars, and costs, for the first offense, Sixty Dollars, and costs, for the second offense, Ninety Dollars, and costs for any subsequent offenses. Any parent or guardian who fails to pay such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail not to exceed five (5) days.

SECTION 2: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this ordinance heretofore enacted by the governing body or the Village of Arpin are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have passed the other provisions, sections, sub sections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after passage and publication as provided by law.
