VILLAGE OF ARPIN, WISCONSIN ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF BEER AND LIQUOR
The Village Board of the Village of Arpin, Wisconsin, do ordain
as follows:

Section 1. No person shall drink from an open container of fermented malt beverages, wine or intoxicating liquors, including glass, can or any other device designed or capable to be used for such purpose on any public street, sidewalk, alley, parking lot or other public property, or upon premises held out to the public for use of their motor vehicles, whether such premises are publicly or privately owned, in the Village, except at municipally approved community functions or events which are authorized by resolution of the Village Board.

Section 2. No person shall be in possession of an open container of fermented malt beverages, wine or intoxicating liquors, including bottle, siass, can or any other device designed or capable of holding such fermented malt beverages, wine or intoxicating liquors on any public street, sidewalk, alley parking lot or other public property, or upon premises held out to the public for use of their motor vehicles, whether such premises are publicly or privately owned, in the Village, except at municipally approved community functions or events which are authorized by resolution of the Village Board.

Section 3. No person or group of persons shall loiter upon any premises licensed for the sale of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors unless said person or persons are within the building on such licensed premises.

Section 4. No person shall consume fermented malt beverages or toxicating liquors on any property licensed for the sale of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors, except within the building on such licensed premises.

Section 5. Any owner, operator, employee or license holder of a licensed premises who shall knowingly permit any person to consume fermented malt beverages or intoxicants on such licensed premises and not within the building so licensed, or shall knowingly permit any person to have any type of open container of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors on such licensed premises and not within the building so licensed shall be guilty of a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 6. The provisions of the Ordinance shall be deemed to be severable and if any section or provision hereof shall be determined to be unconstitutional such determination shall not effect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall forfeit not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$500.00 together with the costs of prosecution for the first violation and not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00 together with the costs of prosecution for esecond violation and upon failure to pay such forfeiture and costs shall be confined to the Wood County Jail for a term not to exceed ninty (90) days or until such forfeiture and costs are paid.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval and publication.
