

VILLAGE OF ARPIN, WISCONSIN  
ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT RESISTING OR  
OBSTRUCTING VILLAGE MARSHAL

The Village Board of the Village of Arpin, Wisconsin, does  
ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW ADOPTED BY REFERENCE.

There is hereby adopted by reference the following section of  
the Wisconsin Statutes relating to resisting or obstructing a  
peace officer:

Section 946.41 Wisconsin Statutes,  
Resisting or Obstructing Officer

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable  
and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have  
passed the other provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs,  
clauses or phrases of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or  
not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any  
provision or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to  
any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the  
Ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons  
or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. REPEALER.

All Ordinances of the Village of Arpin which are in conflict  
herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after  
passage and publication as provided by law.
