## **Ordinance #4**

# AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF ARPIN, WOOD COUNTY WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Arpin, Wood County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follow:

#### Section 1 – REGULATION OF PARKING:

It shall be in violation of the ordinance for any person to park any vehicle on any public street, alley or road within the Village of Arpin, during snow removal, or on Main Street, County Trunk N, beginning at Elm Street East bound and extending approximately 200 feet on both sides of the road.

#### **Section 2 – PENALTY:**

Any person who shall violate this ordinance, shall, receive a first written warning if repeat violations shall occur a monetary penalty will be assessed. First offense in the amount of \$10.00. Second offense will be assessed of \$20. Third through Fifth offense will be assessed at a \$50.00 monetary penalty. Any and all subsequent violators will be towed thereafter at the expense of the registered vehicle owner. All payments will be due within 7 days of offense payable to the Village of Arpin. Repeat violators may be subject to tow at the expense of the registered vehicle owner.

## **Section 3-EXCEPTIONS:**

Exceptions will made upon notification to the Village by leaving a message or talking to a board member. Information needed will be registered vehicle owners name, license plate number, reason why, contact phone number, and duration.

## **Section 4 – <u>REPEALER:</u>**

All ordinances of the Village of Arpin which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

## **Section 5 – SEVERABILTIY:**

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have passed the other provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more of such parts may be declared invalid. If any provision or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

## **Section 7 – EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after passage and publication as provided by law.
