Ordinance #54

AN ORDINANCE TO SET THE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE

Section I – Intent

Village of Arpin, Wood County adapts to the following all-terrain Vehicle Routes for the operation of all-terrain Vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section III.

Following due consideration of their recreational value and weighted against possible dangers public health liability aspects terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, these routes have been created.

Section II – Statutory Authority

These routes were created pursuant to Village Authority and adopted during the regular Village Board Meeting on April 11th, 2007 as authorized by 23.33(8)(b) Wis.. Statutes.

The applicable provisions of 23.33 regulating all ATV's pursuant to routes are adopted.

Section III

All Village streets except for CTH N are designated as routes.

Section IV – Conditions

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators and passengers where applicable

- A. All ATV operators must obey posted 15 MPH speed limits
- B. All ATVs shall ride single file
- C. All ATVs shall yield to pedestrians
- D. This route will only be considered open when signed in accordance with NR64.12 and NR64.12(7)c
- E. This ordinance only applies to public roadways and does not give access or implied access to any private or public lands
- F. No ATVs permitted from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. except for non-recreational purposes

Section V – Enforcement

Any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin shall enforce conditions of use.

Section VI – Penalties

Wisconsin State All-Terrain Vehicle penalties found in s23.33 (13) (a) of Wisconsin Statutes are adopted by this reference.

Section VII – Effective Date
